- Typhoid
- Hepatitis A **
- Hepatitis B **
- Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (Tdap) **
- HPV **
- Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) **
- Varicella (Chicken pox) **
- Meningitis **
- Pneumonia **
- Influenza (Seasonal) **

FEES AND INSURANCE:

Fees vary depending on the type of service and the number of vaccinations required. Payment is required at the time of service. Go to www.uh.edu/healthcenter for more information.

APPOINTMENTS: CALL 713-743-5156

We recommend that you schedule your appointment at least 6-8 weeks prior to the date of anticipated travel to insure that vaccines are administered in a timely manner. Some vaccines require more than one injection to obtain maximum benefit and certain vaccines may not be given in close proximity to each other.
