> Reapportionment









#### **Texas**

- Potentially loss of one of three new congressional seats
  - Houston growth since 2010 driven primarily by Hispanics, some by foreign-born, but mainly USborn Hispanics
  - County of nearly 700,000 means a full seat in the Houston area may be lost
  - Hispanics also crucial role in growth in other parts of the state, including San Antonio, which topped the list of fastest (largest) growth in state last year, even outpacing Houston

- Formulas for program funding
  - Rural targeted programs
  - Head start
  - Medicaid
  - Highway funds
  - Telecomm improvements



- Increases costs of governance
  - Eg. California spending \$90 million for earlier and broader outreach
  - Civic associations divert resources




Connected to Latino and immigrant responses to immigration politics:






### Proportion avoiding daily-life activities (responses by exposure to issue cue)



- Representation in government
  - 2000-2021, TX to gain ~9 seats
- More monies for locale
- Increases costs of governance
  - ▶ Less trust → administrative burden
