Mars Habitation

DAY 3 REFLECT #3: THE PEOPLE IN OUR COMMUNITY



Objectives:

- Students reflect on their own community members and discuss what type of community members they will want in their futuristic community on Mars.
- Students address what type of people character and job skills make their community flourish.

Time: 1.5- 2 hours

Materials:

- Magazines
- Glue/Paper/Poster board
- Markers/Pens/Pencils
- 3-2-1 Template
- Writing journals

Prepare:

- Have various magazines and art supplies ready
- Consider the answers to the Guiding Questions so that you can help students brainstorm.

Activity (step by step)

STEP 1: Recap Previous Week

- 1. Review that last session students created a chart that defined what kind of a community they wanted on Mars.
- 2. Explain that this session they will be deciding what types of people are important to their community here on Earth, and who will be important to their community on Mars.
- 3. Point out that this will help them with their character development for their story.
 - a. This will help define who the people are in your community. What do they do?

 What are their characters like?

STEP 2: Discussion

- 1. Initiate discussion about the people that make up a community
- 2. Document list on posterboard or other large paper in front of room
- 3. Guiding Questions:
 - a. Who is important in your home community? Why?
 - b. What roles must be filled for a community to sustain and flourish?
 - c. What roles must be filled for a community to be culturally rich? (artists, musicians, storytellers, writers etc.)
 - d. What characteristics do contributing community members have? (courage, integrity, kindness, work ethic, etc.)

STEP 3: Activity

- 1. Students work together in their groups to create a collage of all of the people that they have identified are important to their home community.
- Students cut-out pictures/words from magazines or draw pictures and put them on a poster board
- 3. When the collage is finished, students will explain their collage to the class and all of the people they feel are important to a successful community.

STEP 4: Writing Activity
