REMAINING UH REQUIREMENTS TO BE SATISFIED:

Depending on the individual situation, room may be made for the remaining requirements below by having dual/AP credit *where allowed* for courses above. Or, students may complete greater than 30 hours per academic year by taking an extra class in regular semesters or summer semesters. Students may also complete the requirements in additional semesters if needed. Up to 15 of the required total 31 Honors Hours for University Honors as well as WID Core (via HON 3300) may also be completed with the Medicine & Society minor. Lastly, "double-counting" a course towards 2 minors is prohibited.
