Additional Notes:

A student who no longer meets eligibility requirements for the Nursing Dual Degree (GPA, etc) will be required to complete a third minor as traditional/general Liberal Studies major, and waivers for the Foreign Language requirement will no longer apply .

Courses also cannot count toward credit hours for more than 1 minor. Special rules apply to these minor combinations: Communication with Film Studies; Air Force Leadership with National Security Studies. These combinations are not allowed: German with German Area Studies; French with French for the Business Professions; Spanish with Spanish for the Global/Business Professions; Music Literature with Music Theory.
