1. Nine hours in British literature, to include:
  - a. Six hours in British literature before 1798 (ENGL 3302 through 3313, 3317, and 3327).
  - b. Three hours any British literature (3000- or 4000-level).
2. Six hours in American literature, to include:
  - a. Three hours in American literature before 1900 (ENGL 3349, 3350 or 3352).
  - b. Three hours any American literature (3000- or 4000-level).
3. Six hours electives in English (3000- or 4000-level courses, excluding creative writing courses).
4. Three hours in literature since 1950.
5. Fifteen hours in Creative Writing courses, to include:
  - a. Six hours in 3000-level creative writing: ENGL 3329 and either ENGL 3330 or 3331.
  - b. Three hours in ENGL 4355 or 4356.
  - c. Three hours ENGL 4350, 4351, 4352 (or any other 4000-level creative writing courses or repeats of a 4000-level course with approval of the instructor).
  - d. Three hours ENGL 4353 or 4354. (Senior Experience course to be completed within the final three semesters at the senior rank. Prerequisites for these courses will be the form
