PURPOSE: To provide advanced training in musicological research and writing for students pursuing a career in the college-level teaching of musicology, music literature, or music criticism.

MINIMUM ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Bachelor's degree in music.
- Minimum GPA of 3.00 for last 60 semester hours and 3.00 for all music hours. Minimum 3.25 GPA in all music literature and music history courses in undergraduate degree program.
- 3. Submission of TOEFL or IELTS scores (as applicable) that meet University of Houston minimum standards.
- 4. Submission of two research papers, at least one of which should be from an undergraduate music history/literature class, providing evidence of appropriate ability in research and writing.
