PURPOSE: To provide an exclusive two-year period of intensive study in music performance at the graduate level to outstanding student musicians.

MINIMUM ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

1. Bachelor of Music degree, preferably in applied music.
2. Minimum GPA of 3.00 for last 60 semester hours and 3.00 for all music hours.
3. Submission of TOEFL or IELTS scores (as applicable) that meet University of Houston minimum standards.
4. Full senior recital in the undergraduate degree program.
5. Appropriate performance ability as determined in an audition before members of the graduate faculty.
