MASTER OF MUSIC IN MUSIC THEORY

PURPOSE: To provide advanced training in music analysis, research, and writing for students pursuing a career in the college-level teaching of music theory.

MINIMUM ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

1. Bachelor's degree in music.
2. Minimum GPA of 3.00 for last 60 semester hours and 3.00 for all music hours. Minimum 3.25 GPA in all music theory courses in undergraduate degree program.
3. Submission of Graduate Record Examination General Test scores.
4. Submission of TOEFL or IELTS scores (as applicable) that meet University of Houston minimum standards.
5. Submission of theoretical/analytical writing samples and other supporting materials, as requested by the theory faculty, providing evidence of appropriate ability in research and writing.
6. Satisfactory results on entrance examinations in music theory and music history. (Unsatisfactory results will require remedial coursework beyond courses required for the degree.)
