David Wallace, Juilliard School faculty and New York Philharmonic Senior Teaching Artist, has been appointed String Department chair at the Berklee College of Music in Boston. He was the ASTA Keynote Speaker in 2010 and has performed with Mark O'Connor and the Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center. David was a viola student of **Lawrence Wheeler** and CLASS Valedictorian.

John Grimmett (BM '11, Music Ed, studios of **Rob Smith** and **Brian Kauk**) composition *Rain Down the Ruin* with Jason Carlson was presented by The Graduate Music Theatre Writing Program at New York University on July 19-21 as part of The Collaborative, Development and Production (CDP) Series, an initiative to provide an opportunity to present new works by upcoming writers.

At the Opera Theater Pittsburgh, he performed the roles of The Four Servants in *The Tales* of Hoffmann and Belfiore in The Secret Gardener. Gaines performed the role of Malcolm in Verdi's Macbeth with Pittsburgh's Resonance Works. His debut performance with the Utah Opera in March included his role as Pong in the Doucet/Barbe production of *Turandot* followed by his role of Goro in *Madama Butterfly*. Other recent appearances include Carmina Burana with The Erie Philharmonic, a gala performance of Candide (title role) at the Moores School of Music, a debut with The Philadelphia Orchestra in the performance of Strauss' Salome, and a return to Central City Opera for both Mozart's Le Nozze Di Figaro and Heggie's Dead Man Walking.
