- The Gemshorn 2' is transmitted from the Great to the Positive
- The Bourdon 8' in the Pedal is an octave transmission from Subbass 16'
- Wind system with one parallel-shaped bellows fed by a blower
- Suspended key action, self-compensating for seasonal changes
- Keyboards with rosewood naturals and ivory capped ebony sharps
- Compass: Manuals, C-a'''; Pedal, C-f'
