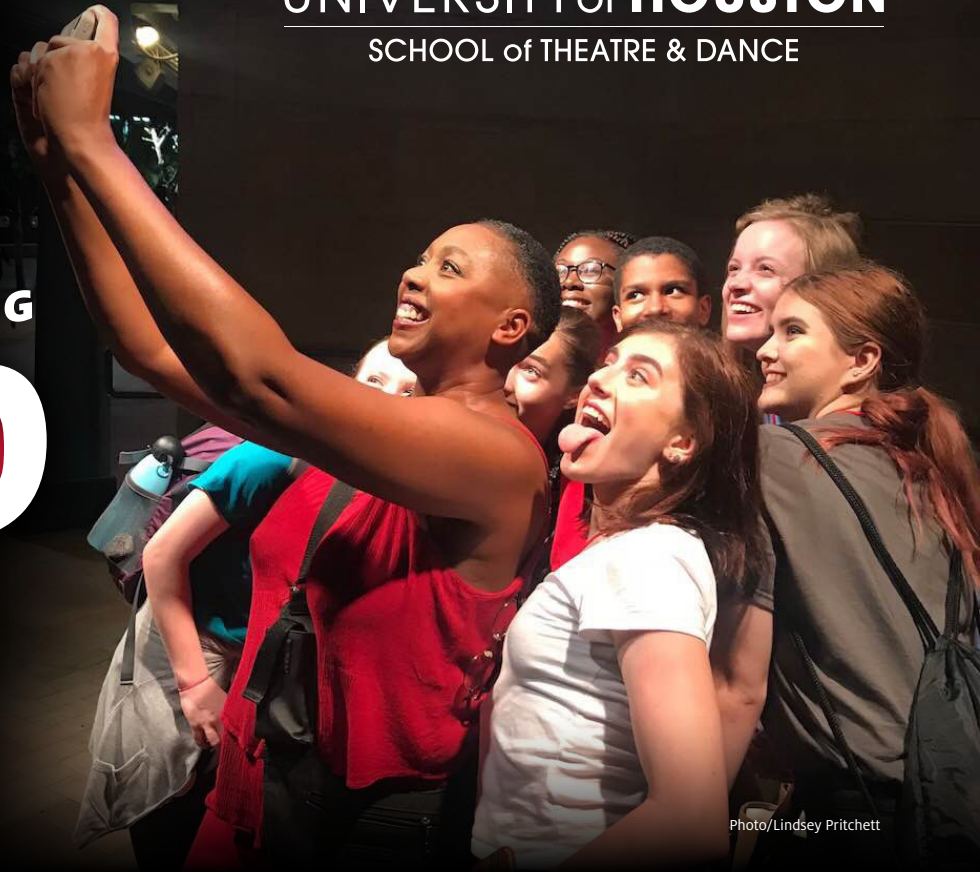

The University of Houston School of Theatre & Dance CAT Camp is a two-week camp for high school students that focuses on actor training and audition technique. Each morning, students will train with UH Theatre Faculty and Houston-area theatre professionals in sessions that focus on various aspects of theatre from improv, movement, acting technique, voice, auditioning, etc. Each afternoon, students will work with a guest director (Destyne Miller- Bush High School or Luis Munoz- Former State OAP Director) in rehearsing a One-Act Play that will be presented in a public performance at the completion of the camp.
