- 1. Why is this an important purpose for the Working Group?
 - Sharing information is super important to learn what each agency is doing in the community.
 - We're not in competition with each other but complement each other.
 - Save COM time finding research objectives that matter to the community.
 - Bring perspective of the community. Help identify community needs.

- 3. What activities would you like to see this group lead toward this purpose?
 - More standardized patients from community, inform on cultural context
 - More participation in community events, to reduce barrier to higher ed, COM
 - Presentations to organizations
 - Research on COVID hesitancy
 - Partner on funding
- 4. On a scale of 1 to 5, how are we doing on this objective?

Most responses were in the 3 to 5 range, with room to improve and grow.

The East End Community Working Group will:

- 1. Mutually share information about community and COM programs and events
 - Engage students, faculty and staff in community events
 - Create a platform to share information



- 2. Prioritize and respond to Third Ward health needs
 - Utilize existing research and reports
 - Jointly respond to funding opportunities
 - Partnered events with community organizations
- 3. Advise and make recommendations to COM on programs and research, such as:
 - Healthy Connections, community health program
 - Admissions Committee
 - Standardized Patients
 - Health Commons Advisory Committee
 - Research Studies
- 4. Hold College of Medicine accountable for service to the community
 - Co-create accountability metrics
 - Provide feedback to COM metrics reports
