

MATH PLACEMENT

Who Should Take the Exam?

- All students who plan to enter a major in the following colleges: Engineering, Natural Sciences and Mathematics (NSM), and Technology (see specific majors).
- Students who need to take higher level science and math courses for graduate school prerequisites.

What If You Have AP or Transfer Credits?

- Scores and transcripts may not be on file when registration begins -- a passing score on the math placement exam will guarantee that students can register for required coursework.

Calculus I - MATH 1431

Online Exam @ Home

1 Attempt

- Be sure to start with a practice exam!
- Use the modules if you need a refresher!
- **Must be completed 72 hours before Orientation.**

Score Chart

Score	Placement
80 or Higher	Calculus I
65 - 79	Pre-Calculus
64 or Lower	No Placement - Take MATH 1330 Exam

ADVISOR TIPS

Placement into Calculus I is required to take CHEM 1331 or higher, PHYS 1301 or higher, and ENGI 1100.

Earning a Second Attempt

If you do not get the score of 80 or higher on your initial attempt, you have the opportunity to try again. Follow these steps:

- Take the MATH 1431 practice exam. You can take unlimited practice exams.
- Earning a score of 80 or higher on a practice exam unlocks **one** additional attempt.
- You must wait 24 hours between earning the score on the practice exam and your second official attempt.

Pre-Calculus - MATH 1330

Online Exam @ Home

2 Attempts

- Students who do not earn a score of 65 or higher on the MATH 1431 exam need to attempt this exam.
- **Recommended to complete 24 hours before orientation.**

65 or Higher	Pre-Calculus
64 or Lower	No Placement - Enroll in MATH 1310
