

Alternative Pre-Nursing Pathway Checklist & Request

Enrolled UH students who complete the following criteria within the first long semester (Fall or Spring) from students' initial matriculation semester in residence are eligible to request a change of major to Pre-Nursing.

Entered UH as a freshman student.

Completed a minimum of 12 semester credit hours from the Course Requirement Checklist after first long semesters (Fall or Spring).

Completed at least one science courses found on the Course Requirement Checklist with a B or higher.*

Completed one math course found on the Course Requirement Checklist with a B or higher.^

Earned a cumulative UH GPA of 3.2 or higher.

Met with an Academic Advisor from the College of Nursing at least once.

Submitted all SAT/ACT scores to UH. <u>Starting Fall 2023, all students admitted to the</u> Traditional BSN Track MUST have SAT/ACT scores on file at UH.

* AP/IB/Dual Credit can be used to fulfill the science requirements. AP/IB/Dual Credit course(s) MUST be listed on the Course Requirement Checklist to be accepted.

^ AP/IB/Dual Credit can be used to fulfill the math requirements. MATH 1342 is a Pre-Nursing requirement and <u>no</u> substitution is allowed. MATH 1314 is the suggested math course, but a higher-level math course can be substituted.
