## POLICY TITLE: MSN TESTING POLICY

---

The specific criteria for determining grades and achievement of course requirements are described in each course syllabus. The administration of examinations and grade assignments are grounded on evidence based practice and industry standards to insure that graduates of the MSN program will be adequately prepared to obtain certification within their chosen specialty.

In addition to the College of Nursing (CON) testing policy, all MSN didactic courses will contain objective testing within the following guidelines:

1. All MSN didactic courses must include objective unit exams except NURS 6351 and NURS 6366.
2. All MSN didactic courses delivered over less than 16 weeks must include a minimum of one formative examination and one comprehensive final examination.
3. All MSN didactic courses delivered over 16 weeks must include a minimum of two (2) formative examinations and one (1) comprehensive final examination.

Students must achieve a weighted exam average of 80% to pass the course.
