For Category 4 (Instructor/Clinical only): department letter outlining nature of candidate's position and role.

For Category 8 (Distinguished Leadership nominees only): department letter outlining evidence in support of the candidate's nomination as posted under the Category 8 description of evidence of merit for nomination.
