Attending one conference, seminar, workshop that involves a global, multicultural, or international dimension. Documentation needed.
Intercultural Activities <i>(Maximum of 2 pts.)</i>	N/A	Taking a leadership role in an ethnic/multicultural or global focused student organization or event on or off campus. Or by interning or volunteering with a local office with a global focus or a community organization that serves international populations. Documentation needed.	Participating in two multicultural or international events or activities. Documentation needed.	Participating in one multicultural or international event or activity. Documentation needed.

Note: Students may not 'double dip'. For example, students may not earn points for learning abroad and also for coursework taken abroad. For the Global Courses and Language Proficiency categories, the maximum number of points students can earn for global courses or foreign language courses is two points. Students can only earn four points through a major or minor for these categories. A student can only earn up to one point for global scholarly work events and intercultural activities/events. Students can only earn two points in these categories through undergraduate research or leadership/internship/volunteer experience.
