## **Recommended Plan for Responsible Conduct of Research by Career Stage**

NIH trainees on the grant types listed here must log a minimum of 8 contact hours for each career stage listed below or every 4 years.

\*Note: Online training alone is not sufficient; substantial face-to-face discussion or video conferencing, combination of didactic and small-group discussions (e.g. case studies), and participation of research training faculty members in instruction are highly encouraged. See <u>NIH Requirement</u> for Instruction in the Responsible Conduct of Research and <u>FY2022 Updated Guidance</u> for additional information.

\*\*The matrix does not limit any individual, in any career stage, from fulfilling additional RCR goals; it is designed as a guide to assist the Principal Investigator in writing a formal RCR plan. Additionally, "a more tailored, discipline-specific approach may better fit the needs of advanced graduate students and those who have transitioned to postdoctoral status" per the updated guidance.
