What to Expect from Colleges

On day 2, students will meet with their academic advisor, and participate in two advising events.

- **College Presentation**

- A college representative will go over important policies and resources for students.
 - Policies - Academic Honesty, Academic Standing, Attendance, and Courseload
 - Resources - LAUNCH, Writing Center, CASA, and other tutoring services

- **Advising and Enrollment**

- Students will meet with their academic advisor, who will provide an overview of the department and major requirements before distributing a customized advising packet outlining the courses necessary for graduation.
- After the advising session, students will head to the computer lab to register for classes.

Enrollment Checklist

- Send official college transcripts and test scores to University of Houston (Central)
- Remove all holds from myUH student account
- Confirm courses with an academic advisor
- Enroll for the summer and/or fall semester

Transfer Coursework and Test Scores

If your student wants to apply transfer coursework or test scores toward their degree, they must submit this information to the UH Office of Admissions as soon as possible.

- **Transfer coursework (including dual credit)**

- Submit electronic college transcript to the UH Office of Admissions.
 - Students should also let their academic advisor know if they have pending transfer coursework.

- **Test Scores (AP and CLEP)**

- AP scores from exams taken in the spring are usually available in early July.
 - Student can check their College Board account to see if their official AP scores have been sent to UH.
 - Students should also let their academic advisor know if they have pending test scores.

Resolve Enrollment Holds

Students should check their MyUH accounts to ensure there are no holds, as this could prevent them from registering for classes on the day of their new student orientation.

New Student Holds:

- Bacterial Meningitis: Students can upload documentation to the To-Do List of their myUH account.
- TSI: Send exemption documentation to TSI@uh.edu or talk to an academic advisor during orientation.
- New Student Advising: This hold will be removed by the student's academic advisor.

Academic Maps

- An academic map is a suggested semester-by-semester sequence of courses that will keep students on track toward timely degree completion.
- Academic maps are not official degree plans, but they serve as a guideline for planning courses throughout a student's four-year journey to graduation.
- Students should regularly meet with their major advisor to confirm their degree requirements.




