Students who have completed ECON 2304 and/or 2305 with a B- or higher may substitute them for ECON 3332 and/or 3334.

>3000-4000 level business courses, except for MIS 3300, MARK 3337, ENTR 3310 and ENTR 3312, are not open to non-business majors unless required for their major, a business minor or special program; these students should take core courses instead. Students are not eligible to change their major to business if they do not meet the requirements by 45 credit hours.
