As a result, students are unaware of the designated avenues to contact/interact within their student government in order to address student needs.

SGA is requesting \$2,650 to cover the cost of hosting a multi-tabling event in the Student Center South Plaza on the week of 8/25-8/29,

2025. \$2,500 would go towards serving food, punch cards for having students visit tables with different information, marketing and outreach efforts, producing merchandise to distribute to students, and \$150 would cover business and administrative fees.

There would be a table for senators, executive, university committee representatives, university administrators, and other relevant personnel to communicate their roles and offer resources.

Benefits:

- Constituency Engagement—increased awareness and interactions with all members of all branches of SGA (e.g., executive, legislative, senate, university committee representatives, etc.).
- Institutional Information—students will be meet officials to address specific issues (e.g., FSAC, CFCC representatives, etc.).
