Safety and Security Committee Charge

The Safety and Security Committee serves in an advisory capacity to the Senior Vice President for Administration and Finance for all matters pertaining to the University of Houston for the purposes of:

- Serving as a line of communication for the University community on items pertaining to safety and security;
- Reviewing safety and security concerns brought to its attention and recommending proposals to address such concerns;
- Promoting co-production of safety and increasing proficiency in safe practices throughout the University community;
- Managing campus carry policy, practices, and reporting;
- Creating sub-working groups as needed (students, faculty, and staff);
- Serving as ambassadors for safety and security to their constituent groups;
- Monitoring progress on campus safety enhancement projects to improve the perception of safety on campus; and
- Helping to ensure that the above charge is implemented in a way to include all members of the University community.

This charge is to be reviewed and updated, as needed, every two years.
