Further Bylaw and Constitutional Adjustments

Whereas, the Constitution and Bylaws do not clearly define what the Student Government and/or Senate Journal are;

Whereas, there is a statute of limitations of ninety (90) class days in the Bylaws;

Whereas, currently, the proposed SGA Constitution requires the President to submit Student Regent selections by November 1st.

Therefore, be it enacted by the Senate of the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

That all references to the "Senate Journal" and "Student Government Association Journal" be struck from the Constitution and Bylaws.

Be it further enacted, That Title V, Article 1, Section 5, Clause 1 of the Student Government Association Bylaws be amended to read:

"Clause 1: No case will be heard by any Student Government Court more than sixty (60) calendar days after the alleged act, occurrence, or transaction which constitutes the principal matter of the case or reasonable discovery thereof."

Be it further enacted, that Article 5, Section 4 of the proposed Student Government Association Constitution be amended to read:

"Section 5.04 Not later than September 1st of each year, the Student Government will solicit applicants for the position of Student Regent. Not later than December 1st, the

President of the Student Government will select five applicants as the Student Government's recommendations for Student Regent and forward these applicants to the Chancellor.

Be it further enacted, that all references to the "Court of Appeals" in the Student Government Association Election Code be replaced with some form of "Supreme Court or designated lower court."
