Cougar Ride Shuttle Line Accessibility

Whereas, the University of Houston is dedicated to creating an inclusive, accommodating, and safe environment for its students;

Whereas, UH Parking and Transportation Services offers a new pilot after-hours transportation service;

Whereas, the Cougar Ride Shuttle Line does not currently offer a vehicle with disability access;

Whereas, Students requiring a disability ramp are unable to use this resource provided by the University;

Therefore, be it resolved by the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

That Cougar Ride Shuttle Line provide an option for a vehicle with disability access for students on all operational days and hours.

Be it further resolved, that the University of Houston Auxiliary Service will coordinate with UH Parking and Transportation Services to monitor the utilization rate of the Cougar Ride vehicle with disability access;

Be it further resolved, that if the utilization of the disability option is high then Auxiliary Services will look to expand disability access to all Cougar Ride vehicles;

Be it further resolved, that the Cougar Ride Shuttle with disability access be operational and accessible to students on April 12, 2019.
