**Dress for Success Act**

**Whereas**, all members of the Student Government Association are held to the highest regard by the student body;

**Whereas**, Senate meetings are considered formal events held by the Student Government Association;

**Whereas**, prioritizing professional growth is not only critical to the success of Student Government Association's initiatives but to the success of the elected officials during their term;

**Whereas**, business casual footwear will be defined as closed toed shoes or dress shoes with the exception of open toed heels;

**Whereas**, business casual bottoms will be defined as jeans when worn with a belt and shirt tucked in, dress pants, skirt, trousers, dress, or other long pants, excluding joggers, jeans with holes, and sweat pants;

**Whereas**, business casual tops will be defined as a dress shirt, blouse, collared shirt, blazers, and overcoats, excluding graphic tees;

**Whereas**, business casual will not allow for headwear including ball caps, trucker hats, beanies, helmets, and sun hats, with the exception of any religious or medical head headwear.

**Therefore, be it enacted by the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:**

Every member is required to abide by the dress code explicitly stated in this bill;

**Be it further enacted**, that the Speaker of the Senate shall be tasked with the enforcement of this legislation.
