Why become a Research Center Affiliate?

What are the requirements?

MH-RITES Research Center Affiliate requirements include:

- Enrolled as a PhD student or a practicing licensed professional or a certified peer specialist in the area of mental health,
- A focus and/or interest in mental health,
- Your program of research reflects the mission and vision of The MH-RITES Research Center,
- Your program of research promotes the inclusion of social, racial, economic, and political justice considerations throughout their activities, and
- Pursues or interest in pursuing the mental health research.

How do I apply?

Organize and submit an application to include responses to each of the following questions (limit to 2 pages single spaced):

- a) Provide a brief bio that highlights your program of research and current project(s).
- b) Identify and describe any research alignment or interest you have with the Center's mission, Research Fellows, or projects.
- c) What are you hoping to gain from becoming a Research Affiliate with the Center?
- d) As a Research Center Affiliate, are you willing to be an active member of the Center by attending annual events? Are there certain Center events/opportunities that you would like to see?



What happens after I apply?

All applications will initially be reviewed for eligibility criteria by the Center Director. Each eligible and completed application will be submitted to The MH-RITES Center Research Affiliate committee comprised of Board members for review and approval.
