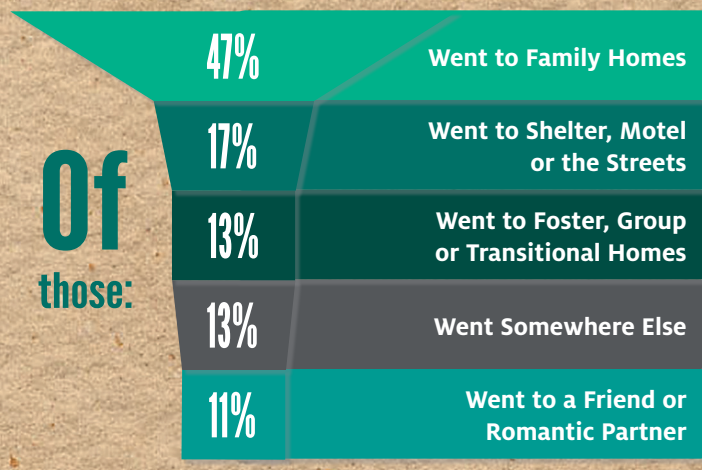

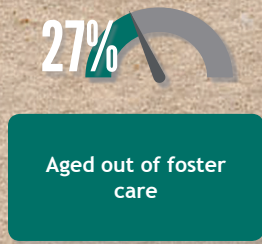
135 Reported that they had been involved with juvenile probation at some point. (33%)

42% reported they had **aged out** of the juvenile justice system

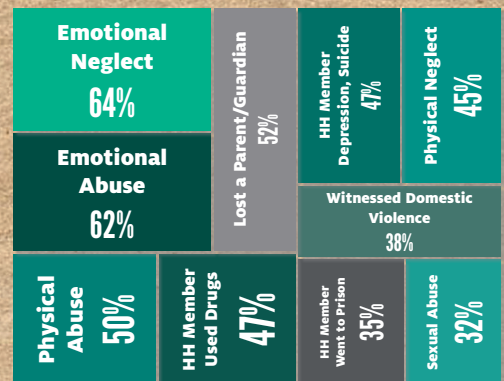


55% reported they are **currently homeless** because they were **kicked out** of a family or relative home



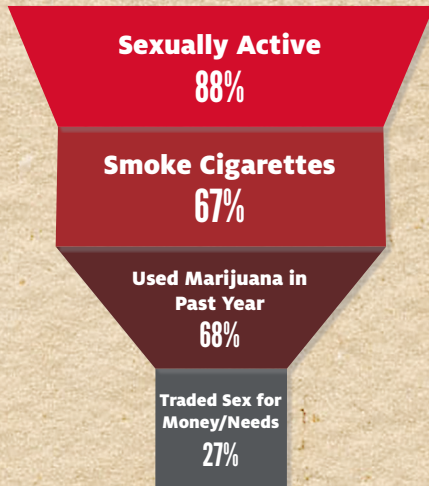
ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES:

ASSESS 10 TYPES OF TRAUMA

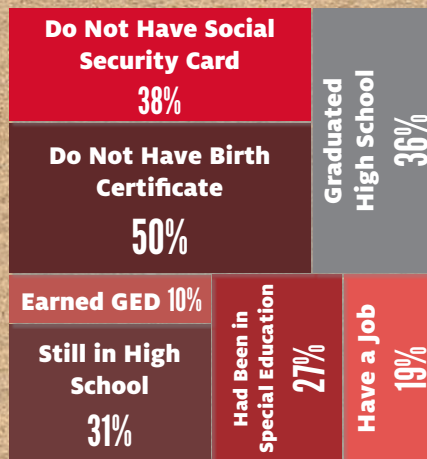


Mean Score = 4.67

Reported there is no adult they can go to for emotional support



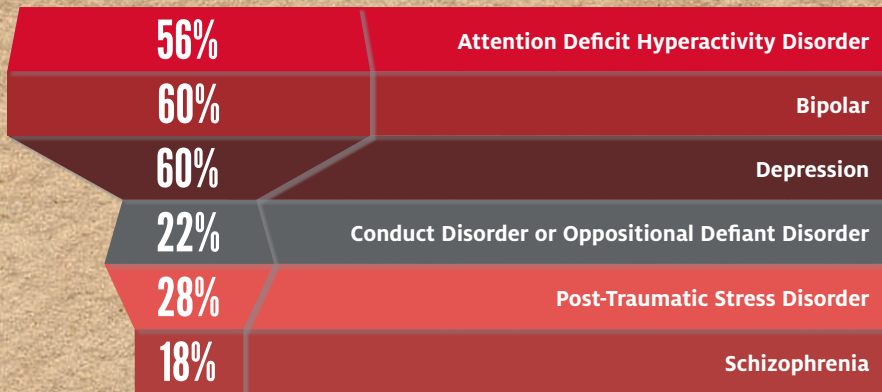
Say there is no adult in their life who cares about them
