SALARY SURVEY RESULTS FOR 2015 GCSW MSW GRADUATES

The *Job Market Survey* for 2015 *MSW Graduates* was emailed out to 153, 2015 UH-GCSW graduates as part of an annual GCSW research study of job search methods and reported salaries for new MSW graduates. A total of 83 responses were received at a 54% response rate. 88% of graduates who responded reported being currently employed.

Salaries for 2015 Graduates

The average salary for 2015 UH GCSW MSW Graduates working full-time was reported at \$46,701 (based on 66 responses). The range of salaries reported for those working full-time was from \$30,000-\$67,000, with a median range of \$52,000-53,999 (based on 66 responses).

Sources of Jobs

The most frequently reported sources for locating jobs were: Contact from networking with alumni, family, friends, social workers; job referral service (Indeed, USAJobs.gov, etc.); field placement site staff offered a position or tip on a job elsewhere; current or prior employer; and GCSW online job board.

Out of the 71 UH-GCSW MSW graduates that reported working, 92% are working within the Greater Houston area.
