<b>Job Description</b>	<p>The Behavioral Health Consultant (BHC) is a licensed behavioral health provider who will function as an integral member of the primary care team, providing brief consultative visits to children, adolescents, adults and their families utilizing the Primary Care Behavioral Health Consultative Model (PCBH). The BHC is a vital member of the patient care team to support integration of services between the medical and behavioral health care rendered to the patients in the form of a brief intervention. Delivering evidence-based brief interventions to a large variety of patients with emotional and mental health issues seen in the primary care setting is at the core of this position. At times, the BHC will meet with the patients for a single visit and provide recommendations to the primary care provider in order to enhance the patient's overall well-being. If needed at the recommendation of the BHC, they will schedule patients for a longer encounter with the goal of further assessment with appropriate follow up care with a BHS. The BHC plays a vital role on the treatment team and is central to the Primary Care Behavioral Health Consultation Model (PCBH). The BHC is responsible for patient satisfaction, appropriate utilization of health care resources, cooperation with primary care providers and for high quality health care. The Behavioral Health Consultant sets the example of teamwork within the center working closely with assigned support staff and other staff members.</p>
