Job Description	The UT Division of Child Safety and Integrated Care is seeking an experienced mental health clinician to serve as a therapist in a unique program for children with chronic medical conditions. The program aims to address the problems of medical non-adherence and overuse of inpatient services among children with chronic conditions in a holistic manner that includes a heavy emphasis on psychological therapy and social services. Typical patients have a medical diagnosis that is complicated by ongoing psychosocial stressors that result in recurrent complications, such as diabetes with repeated inpatient stays for keto acidosis. Patients have mental health issues related to depression, anxiety and adjustment disorder. The therapist will maintain a caseload of patients and be responsible for providing individual, family and group therapy on a daily basis. Patients will come to the program during weekdays (Monday-Thursday) only and go home each evening.
Qualifications	Current license from the Texas Board of Social Work Examiners to practice as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW). Minimum Education: Master's degree in a behavioral science. Minimum Experience: One year of experience in a mental health setting.
