<b>Job Description</b>	<p>Operates as a behavioral health consultant (BHC) on the medical team utilizing the Primary Care Behavioral Health (PCBH) model of care. Acting as a generalist, the BHC sees patients of all ages and with wide ranging medical, behavioral health and behaviorally influenced conditions. As a fully integrated member of the primary care team, the BHC provides episodic behavioral health services and interventions to a high volume of patients.</p> <p><b>MAJOR DUTIES &amp; RESPONSIBILITIES:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prioritize and provide on-demand visit as well as manage scheduled visits to individuals, couples, and/or family adhering to the norm of a fast-paced primary care environment;</li> <li>• Utilize therapeutic modalities that match the fast-paced primary care environment such as behavioral and cognitive behavioral modalities, solution focused brief therapy, motivational interviewing, etc.</li> <li>• Provide consultation to and coordinate care of patients with health center primary care staff;</li> <li>• Consult with PCPs in real-time to enhance understanding of the patient, provide decision support for treatment planning and assist in the implementation and monitoring of biopsychosocial treatment plans;</li> <li>• Close all charts within forty-eight (48) hours of visit - ability to do concurrent/concordant charting/typing; including assessments, progress notes, and billing;</li> <li>• Participate in after-hours call schedule;</li> <li>• Be flexible to work between sites;</li> <li>• Assist in provider training and education in integrated behavioral health-primary care model;</li> <li>• Participate in behavioral health quality improvement activities;</li> <li>• Participate in local behavior health trainings and conferences;</li> <li>• Make appropriate referrals for patients, including psychiatric (within or outside of HOPE Clinic);</li> <li>• Participate in case staffing and administrative meetings;</li> <li>• Participate in clinical supervision, and seeks peer consultation as needed;</li> <li>• Abide by HOPE Clinic's and departments' policies and procedures;</li> <li>• Attend on-site/off-site community engagement activities and on-site/off-site clinic events as needed;</li> <li>• Perform other duties as assigned to support HOPE Clinic's Vision, Mission, and Values.</li> </ul>
