Job Description	<p>An HHCI Clinician is a licensed mental health therapist (LCSW, LPC, LCDC, LMFT) who offers strengths-based support for persons living with moderate to severe mental health difficulties and disorders, serious mental illness, trauma, and personality disorders. Clinical work will include working with a wide spectrum of individuals struggling with moderate to severe mental health difficulties. They are responsible for meeting with clients and their families, facilitating support groups, communicating with interdisciplinary team, guiding clients in the referral process, participating in our CBT and DBT programs, and serving as a representative for training events and programs administered or attended by the HHCI.</p> <p>This person will have experience in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and Dialectic Behavioral Therapy (DBT) and will participate in both Clinical programs at HHCI. DBT experience is required.</p> <p>Position is Monday thru Friday 8am-5pm with the possibility of working one evening shift per week to facilitate support group. Position may require occasional travel throughout the city of Houston and surrounding areas as part of networking and outreach duties.</p>
Qualifications	<p>Applicants for the position must have a master's degree in psychology, counseling, or social work, and at least one year of experience in a clinical setting. Applicants must have experience in DBT and CBT modalities and be adept at following program curriculum.</p> <p>Preferred applicants will possess licensure (LPC, LMSW, LCSW, LMFT, or LCDC). Preferred applicants will have experience facilitating groups, conducting psychosocial interviews, connecting clients with referrals in the community, crisis intervention, and providing CBT and DBT services. Proficiency in Spanish is preferred but not required.</p> <p>Applicants must be self-driven and adaptable. Applicants must possess technical, clerical, critical thinking and interpersonal skills relevant to total client care in order to safely and efficiently treat clients. Applicants must have the ability to prioritize work with minimal supervision, in order to independently carry out duties.</p>
