Provide supervision of residential staff and assure correct supervising ratios for staff to clients are in place. Work with staff on schedules, vacation, callins, transportation, food services, and calendar activities. Work with staff for appropriate documentation of clients as required and report to the treatment team on progress. Meet with staff and children in care for evaluation and feedback of care and service delivery. Ensure the overall safety and compliance of shelter care operations by conducting rounds, inspections, supervision, work-orders, and facility checklists. Ensure that all shelter licenses and certifications are up to date. Receives and resolved or assists the management in resolving residence complaints and service recovery process. Managing household budget, organizing activities and making transportation arrangements as needed. Participate in departmental, all staff, and mandatory meetings, and required training opportunities. Participate in on-call rotation of the supervisory staff. Perform other duties as required by supervisor.
