Position works with a variety of partners including: Local Departments of Health, Council of Governments, Regional Advisory Council, City, County and State Emergency Management officials, healthcare, schools, community based organizations and other entities as needed to ensure local and regional plans are integrated and well-coordinated. Collaborates with other regional staff in public health preparedness activities. Manages and facilitates regional workgroups to develop local plans with key stakeholders. Works with the DSHS Center for Health Emergency Preparedness and Response and Local Health Departments to ensure coordination and integration of regional/local plans with statewide planning efforts. Actively participates and/or serves in a supporting role to meet the agency's obligations for disaster response and/or recovery. Works under general direction with extensive latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment.
