Job Description	The incoming mental health professional will join a dynamic interdisciplinary team that consists of physicians, advanced practice providers, nurses, social workers, and several others. Sub-specialty services included in this center revolve around the needs of our patients who have a history of a cancer diagnosis, some of whom are currently engaged in active treatment. In addition, a significant number of patients seek medical care at MD Anderson because of the novel clinical trials that may not be available in elsewhere. These patients may be living with an advanced cancer or a cancer associated with a poor prognosis. Neuropsychological assessment services are provided throughout the trajectory of care including for long term survivors.
	Our clinic serves adolescent and young adult patients. Cancer types vary widely in this population and patients are referred from adult clinics across the institution, as well as through the Children's Cancer Hospital.
	The primary responsibility of the Senior Counselor - Pediatrics Patient Care (Neuropsychology) is to provide individualized outpatient neuropsychological testing through the ambulatory child and adolescent center. The Senior Counselor provides services under the direction and supervision of a faculty neuropsychologist.
Qualifications	The ideal candidate will have a Masters degree in psychology or related mental health discipline, and at least three years of post-masters related experience including previous experience in neuropsychological assessment. Bilingual assessment experience is strongly preferred (English/Spanish).
