 Oversees patients' care and progress in treatment in order to prevent both the under-utilization and over-utilization of inpatient treatment services through feedback to and from the patient, significant others, the treatment team, third party payers and community resources. Provides third party payers with clinical data in order to justify, advocate for, and arrange for necessary services for the patient while in the
hospital, as well as after discharge. 3. Works with a multidisciplinary treatment team to develop an individualized treatment and discharge plan that enables patients to quickly begin or return to outpatient treatment programs;
 Develops a discharge plan that will support patient's ongoing recovery and development.
5. Assesses patients at admission and throughout the treatment program; conducts interviews with patients and significant others to determine assets as well as challenges to optimal patient functioning both while in the program and upon discharge to a lesser restrictive level of care.
6. Establishes and maintains relationships with community resources to assist patient's needs at discharge for ongoing treatment, residence, financial support, transportation, education, and vocational rehabilitation.
7. Provides direct services to patients which includes the following: assessment, treatment and discharge planning; individual, couple, and family education, crisis prevention and supportive counseling.
8. Must be able to respond to emergency situations.9. May be assigned to act as mentor to new employees and to social work
