Free COVID-19 On-Campus Testing

The University of Houston partnered with the well-known testing company Curative to provide a free, walk-up kiosk on campus where **faculty, students and staff** can be tested regardless of whether they have symptoms. The testing kiosk offers painless PCR saliva swabs with results returned by email within 48 hours of the test arriving at the lab.

The Curative kiosk is open to faculty, staff and students with their UH Cougar Card identification.

Curative Testing Appointments:

- Appointments beginning Monday, Feb. 8, 2021 can be made on the [updated appointment site](#).
- By appointment only, the testing service is available in front of the UH Student Center South from 8 am to 5 pm, Monday-Friday.

Student Health Center Testing:

The Student Health Center provides COVID-19 testing for students, faculty and staff who become symptomatic or have been identified as exposed on the UH campus, AND are participating in on-campus face-to-face courses, living or working on campus.

- Testing is available at the [Student Health Center](#), located in the [Health 2 Building](#) by appointment only.
- Individuals who meet the criteria should call 713-743-4510 to setup their appointment for testing
- Priority is given to students, faculty and staff who are on campus
- Individuals tested will be contacted with results (usually within 24-48 hours after being tested)
