

A. Butterfly Templates

Please print this page on letter-size paper at 100% scale.



B. Cutting Instructions



Materials.

Aluminum Cans Butterfly Template Scissors Paper Clip Paper Towel Carefulness

Wash and dry the aluminum can.







Cut aluminum cans with the template.

Attach the template with a paper clip and cut along the edge.

Try a bigger can(473ml).

You can make two butterflies from large cans.

We have three butterflies!



Cut a butterfly template.

C. Attaching Instructions



Remove bottom of can first. Make a hole at the bottom side and begin to cut out.

Caution: Don't hurt your hand.




Nutrition facts side is recommended.

Cut off the top.

Cut toward the top.
