

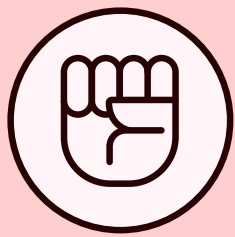

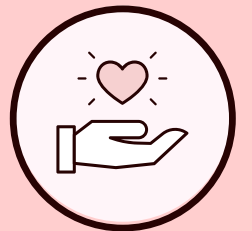


MENTORSHIP
