Transfer Credit Limit

A maximum of 66 hours (grades C- or better) of 1000/2000 level transfer hours may be applied toward a UH degree. From the above courses, choose the 66 hours that best meet the degree requirements for your UH degree combination (Major, Double Major, Double Degree, and Minor). Any additional hours over 66 cannot be used to satisfy degree requirements.
