A maximum of 66 hours (grades C- or better) of 1000/2000 level transfer hours may be applied toward a UH degree.

### Texas Undergraduate In-State Tuition Enrollment Cap

Under current rules, Texas resident undergraduate students who enrolled for the first time in a Texas public institution of higher education in Fall 1999 or later may be charged a premium tuition rate after they reach an established enrollment cap. \*All majors for the B.B.A. allow 9 hours of General Elective credit. Students with transfer credit of 6 hours for Institutionally Designated Component Area Options and/or 3 hours of Social and Behavioral Science in addition to ECON 2301 or ECON 2302 may transfer those credits as General Electives toward the B.B.A., or utilize the 9 hours of General Electives for any unused transferable courses.
