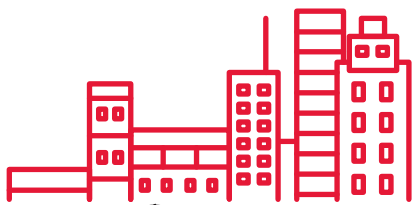

FRESHMAN STUDENTS

All COT applicants must meet the general freshman admission requirements and complete specific high school credits, which are listed below.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

Some COT majors have additional requirements for transfer students, which are listed below.

General Transfer Admission Requirements

ADMISSION TYPE	HOURS OF COLLEGE-LEVEL CREDIT	CUMULATIVE GPA
Assured Admission	15 or more**	2.5
Individual Review*	15 or more**	2.25 – 2.49

*If you don't meet the assured admissions requirements, we may consider additional factors in the admissions process. If we require additional documentation, we'll request those materials from you.

**If you've earned less than 15 hours of college-level credit, you'll have to meet freshman admission criteria to be admitted. Only credits obtained after earning a high school credential will be counted toward the 15 hours.
