Implementation of the International Baccalaureate Diploma and

College Credit Requirements as per Senate Bill 111

The Schate Bill 111 requires all Texas public colleges and universities to adopt a policy regarding the awarding of academic credit to entering freshmen who have completed a post-secondary level program while still in high school. Those programs include AP courses, CLEP exam credit, and International Baccalaureate Diploma (IBD) courses.

This is to inform the members of the Undergraduate Council that the UH policy regarding the IB credits has been updated in accordance with the SB 111 text and reads:

"The University of Houston recognizes the comprehensive and rigorous curriculum of the International Baccalaureate (IB) and offers possible credit for scores of 4, 5, 6 or 7 on higher-level examinations. An entering freshman who holds an IB diploma will be granted at least 24 college credit hours if he or she has scored 4 or better on the IB exams. IB (HL) scores sent to the University of Houston will be reviewed for credit."
