Computer Graphics Minor Change

The introduction of the Digital Media (DMTC) Bachelor of Science degree and prerequisite changes to GRTC courses causes a need to make a small change to the Computer Graphics minor. The current Computer Graphics Minor requires the following courses:

ITEC 1301 or demonstrated computer proficiency
GRTC 2350
GRTC 3353
GRTC 4376
And 6 hours from GRTC 3351, GRTC 4373, ITEC 2332, COMM 1301, 2320, or 3353.

The proposed new configuration of courses for the minor would be as follows:

ITEC 1301 or demonstrated computer proficiency
GRTC 2350
GRTC 2351
GRTC 2352
GRTC 3353
GRTC 3354
GRTC 4374

That's 18 hours and consists of computer graphics, digital photography, web design, visual communications, video preproduction and production, and video post production. It's a great mix and would help the students become competent in computer graphics.
