

Proposed changes to undergraduate BA degree in English with a Concentration in Linguistics (submitted to the College Committee Fall 2008)

Rationale:

This proposal corrects a typographical error in the catalog by inserting ENGL 3317 (The British Novel Before 1832) into the list of courses that satisfy the pre-1798 British literature requirement for the Linguistics Concentration. (ENGL 3317 is currently only listed as meeting that requirement for Literature students, so the Creative Writing proposal submitted Fall 2008 and this proposed change adds ENGL 3317 to the other two degree plans.)
