Summary of changes to the B.S. in Interdisciplinary Studies Degree Plans and Waiver for the 120-credit hour Requirement

CUIN Department, College of Education, July 2009

Please consider this waiver as *compelling academic reason* for three of our degree plans to exceed the 120 credit hour limit.

At approximately the same time that our program learned about this requirement to reduce hours on degree plans to 120, we learned of a second legislative requirement that elementary teachers be certified to teach grades Early Childhood to Sixth grade (EC-6), an addition of two grades worth of content beyond the existing Early Childhood to Fourth grade certification range.

We have carefully examined all of our course offerings in light of the dual legislative requirements to reduce degree plans to 120 credit hours and increase the scope of content covered, as well as with reference to the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) degree requirements for the Interdisciplinary degree and the unit accreditation standards of our national accrediting association, the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE). Given these four guiding frameworks, we have been able to reduce our total required credit hours for all degree plans for the B.S. in Interdisciplinary Studies.

B.S. in Interdisciplinary Studies for Students Teaching Grades EC-6

We have reduced all three of the EC-6 Generalist plans by four credit hours. Reducing any additional courses would not allow us to meet these certification and accreditation requirements.

- EC-6 Generalist: 126 hours
- EC-6 Bilingual Generalist: 135 hours
- EC-6 Special Education/Generalist: 135 hours

[Note: The EC-6 Bilingual Generalist and EC-6 Special Education/Generalist degree plans are built upon the Generalist plan, with additional specialty courses, so they exceed the 120-hour limit accordingly.]

Specifically, we eliminated these two courses from elementary degree plans:

- 1) CUIN 3318 Phonics in the Reading Process. This course content will be integrated into two other required courses beginning in Fall 2009; and
- 2) CUIN 3113 Educational Technology for Children III. This course content will be integrated into one of the required student teaching courses for EC-6 students.

B.S. in Interdisciplinary Studies for Students Teaching Grades 4-8

For informational purposes, the middle school 4-8 degree plans have met the 120-hour limit.

- 4-8 Language Arts: 120 hours
- 4-8 Mathematics: 120 hours
- 4-8 Science: 120 hours
- 4-8 Social Studies: 120 hours

For all 4-8 plans, these changes have been made:

1) CUIN 3123 Educational Technology for Children III. This course content will be integrated into one of the required student teaching courses for 4-8 students.

2) CUIN 3221 will be taken in QUEST 1 as an introductory course, replacing CUIN 3300. The course will provide an introduction to teaching middle school students in particular. As a 2-hour course, it will ensure integration with the technology course, CUIN 3121, mirroring the introductory sequence already in practice in the EC-6 program. (Note: this course CBM will be submitted in Fall 2009. For Fall 2009 and Spring 2010, students will continue to take CUIN 3300.)

3) CUIN 3222 will be taken in QUEST 2 as an integrated curriculum course. This course will replace EDUC 3301 and will provide coordination of methods and field experience, much like CUIN 3202 does in the EC-6 program. It will integrate with the technology course 3122. This course will be offered first in Fall 2010 as the first students through on this degree plan will need it then.
