Other than a typo in <u>UCC 0129 10S</u> in item #3 (**If a "student" admits a student** to a graduate program...), we have no concerns and support the proposal.

<u>UCC 0130 10S</u>, GPSC 6556, Student reinstatement vs Readmission. Did the committee intend to say "...students who wish to resume studies more than 5 years after they are *originally admitted*"... or did they mean "5 years after they were last enrolled"? Other than this clarification, we have no concerns and support the proposal.

<u>UCC 0135 10S</u> - Proposal for the use of 5000-level courses. Is UC aware and supportive of this change? When generating a transcript, 5000-level courses taken before this policy (graduate courses) and those taken after this policy (undergraduate courses) must be differentiated. How is the change communicated to other institutions/programs to which our students may transfer? A numbering plan should be developed and communicated to all departments offering 5000-level courses.
