Dr. Charlson,

We agree that the procedures for students to change majors and/or programs should be more structured so that records can be maintained appropriately, colleges and departments can participate effectively, and students are served more efficiently. I do not think that submitting a new admissions application for each change that a student wants to make is the best solution, however.

There should probably be two separate procedures - one that uses a "change of major/college/degree" form (possibly an electronic form with work-flow approvals); and one that requires students to reapply for admission.

<u>Change of major/college/degree form (procedure)</u> is for students who want to change their major/college/degree within the same career (and have not completed the program/degree that they are currently pursuing)

<u>Application for Admission/Readmission</u> is for students who want to change careers (GRAD to UGRD or vice versa) or for students who have completed a program and want to be considered for a different one (ie, completed a Master's degree and want to pursue a Ph.D.)
