While a policy is a first step, it will only be successful if the University is able to truly enforce it. Simply informing members of the community about the policy and reporting them through the TTF does not truly have any "teeth". What will be done if a particular individual is reported multiple times? There are also many instances when a community member may witness an individual smoking, but may be unable to identify them for reporting purposes. I believe this is a positive step, but we will need stronger enforcement policies to realize greater success.
